“The Arab Contractors” selects EGYPTROL/ PESCO for the Engineering of South Helwan PP

“The Arab Contractors” has signed a contract with EGYPTROL www.egyptrol.com, in cooperation with PESCO www.pesco-eg.com, for partnership in South Helwan 3x650 super critical power plant Civil Works package CP-102.

EGYPTROL/ PESCO is the selected Engineering partner for “The Arab Contractors” for this project.

The pre-bid scope covers preliminary designs to allow The Arab Contractors to bid for the Package, including preliminary design for civil and electromechanical works including the preparation of Calculation reports, Preliminary BOQ's for lump sum items, preliminary design drawings, design review of all suppliers' quotations and technical support in the preparation of the final proposal that will be submitted by Arab Contractors to UEEPC.

EGYPTROL/ PESCO post-award scope covers full design and workshop documentation of the Civil Works package as identified by UEEPC issued RFP.

The Arab Contractors had a history of cooperation with the same engineering partners EGYPTROL/ PESCO in the bidding phase for the Iraq's Samawa, and Diwania power plants projects. The Arab Contractors (in Consortium with Elsewedy Electric) did win the EPC contract for the execution of Diwania 4x125MW simple circle power plant. The Consortium is currently executing the project.
